
SDG 1 Progress Against SDG1- No Poverty for Southern Technical University


1. Year-over-Year Comparison of Scholarships and Community Participants


2. Trend Analysis of Employment Rate and Outreach Hours

3. Cumulative Impact of Scholarships and Community Participants



4. Multi-Metric Comparison for 2023


This radar chart provides a multi-metric comparison for the year 2023. Each axis represents a different key metric, including scholarships awarded, community participants,
